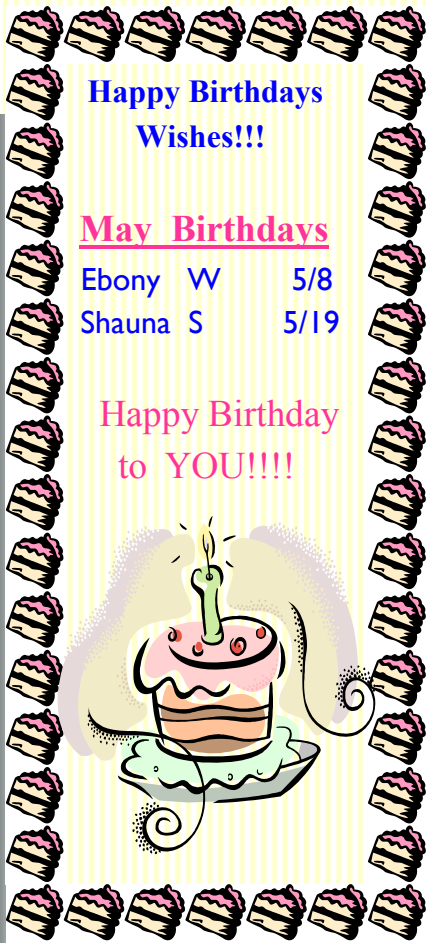

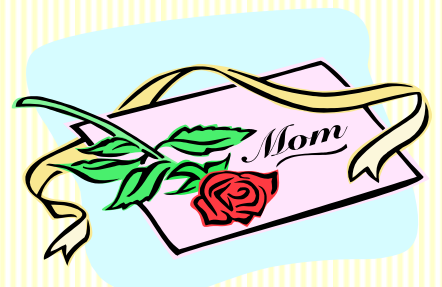

1st Mother's Day: May 10, 1908; Founded by Anna Jarvis; made a national holiday in 1914 by President Wilson

Cinco de Mayo is often confused with Mexican Independence Day. Mexican Independence Day is celebrated on September 16th -- it was the day that declared its independence from Spanish rule. Cinco de Mayo is the anniversary of the 1862 Batalla de Puebla.

Worldwide, the sales of Mexican beer, tequila, and Mexican food are at their yearly peak around Cinco de Mayo. Let's face it, you can't go the day without having at least one shot of tequila and a taco, right?

The south refused to honor the dead on Memorial Day until after World War I when the meaning of Memorial Day changed from honoring civil war dead to honoring Americans who died fighting in any war.

Since the late 1950s on the Thursday just before the Memorial day, around 1200 soldiers of the 3d U.S. Infantry place small American flags at each of the more than 260,000 gravestones at Arlington National Cemetery. They then patrol 24 hours a day during the weekend to ensure that each flag remains standing. In 1951, the Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts of St. Louis began placing flags on the 150,000 graves at Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery as an annual Good Turn, a practice that continues to this day.

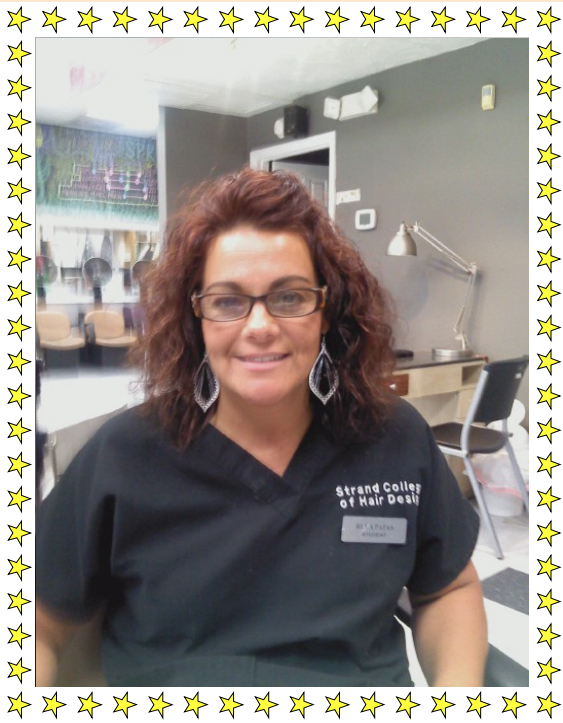
Great news!!!!
